

## CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS Festival Trailer and Festival Sujet 2016

**this human world** – International Human Rights Film Festival, is looking for a festival trailer and a visual festival sujet for its 9th edition. The festival is taking place December 1st-11th 2016, in Vienna, Austria.

We are looking for innovative video or film works with a length of 30-60 seconds dealing with human rights related issues, that can serve as festival trailer for this year's edition of **this human world** - International Human Rights Film Festival.

Furthermore we are looking for a visual festival sujet, for printed matter as posters, postcards, stickers etc., the sujet should be an artistic, visual approach to human rights issues.

Just 'cause you feel it / Doesn't mean it's there – sings Thom Yorke in Radiohead's song *There There*.

Simultaneous presence and absence of an idea of a global concept, questioning of alleged realities. A paradox?

A cynical voice? Vague doubts? Self assurance or despite? An Appeal!

Take this line as incentive, not as dogma but as distal glimpse of light to guide your ideas, let those words confuse you, wind it in all directions and find your own connections and associations between those words, human rights and a time out of joint.

It is possible to submit either trailer or sujet, or trailer and sujet. Connected, conceptual and innovative works might be given priority.

### Formal Conventions:

The trailer has to be between 30 und 60 seconds long.

There are no restrictions concerning technique, narrative form and style.

There are no stylistic restrictions for the sujet either, **this human world** reserves the right to modify the sujet for print, in consultation with the artist.

To promote **this human world**, the trailer will be released ahead of the festival in cinemas, on TV and on the internet.

During the festival it will be shown before each film.

The sujet is supposed to visually represent the festival's identity to the outside and will be used for different kinds of printed matter and on the internet.

A Jury consisting of artists, filmmakers and the festival directors will nominate the winner.

The best works will be presented in an exhibition in Vienna, during the festival.

The winning sujet and trailer will each be awarded with 500€.
