Enrolment

After the pre-registration, you have to enrol personally with the required documents at the Academy Registrar's Office at Schillerplatz.

Tuition Fees

For admission to study, the correct amount must be paid by the end of the registration period, otherwise you risk to not being enrolled or being deregistered!

The regulations regarding the amount and possible exemptions from tuition fees depend on a range of different requirements. Under certain circumstances a fee waiver or refund of the fees can be granted. Please find more information on our website (see link *general study information*).

The students' union fee (ÖH-Beitrag) is not part of the tuition fees and must be paid each semester by all students without exception.

German Language Courses for Students

The Academy of Fine Arts Vienna offers German language classes for students in the Fine Arts and Scenography programs to reach the level B1. If places are still available, students from other programs (e.g. PhD) may participate in the German courses (see link *general study information*).

Mandatory Residence Registration

By law all people living in Austria have to register their place of residence at the registration office. All information, contacts of the registration service centres, online reservation for appointments, application form Please consult the weband required documents are available on the website of the city of Vienna. You'll get a residence re-

gistration certificate which is required in several cases such as opening a bank account, for voting rights or similar.

The residence registration is not connected to any visa or residence permit!

Registration Certificate for EU and EEA nationals

All EU and EEA citizens residing in Austria longer than 3 months need to apply for the registration certificate at the competent authority, the Municipal Department 35 (MA35). site of the city of Vienna for further information about contacts, online reservation for appointments and application forms.

Residence permit for non-EU and non-EEA nationals

You have to apply for a residence permit either in advance at an Austrian authority abroad, or after arriving in Vienna at the **Municipal Department 35** (MA35). 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Psychological counselling for students

The Academy of Fine Arts Vienna offers its students psychological counselling and support with:

- Emotional conditions that are difficult to deal with when alone
